

The Knights of Columbus Poster Contest

The <u>Knights of Columbus Poster Contest</u> is open to all Catholic Elementary schools located in the City of Red Deer. Posters to be completed in color on white paper either 8.5" by 14" or 11" by 17". Student's name, grade(combined grades must be specific) and classroom should be clearly printed on the bottom of the poster and the school name on the back of the poster so that the posters can

be returned to the appropriate school and classroom. Entries will be judged based on Christian message, content, originality, and artistic composition/talent. This year there are five separate categories: grade 1, grade 2, grade 3, grade 4, and grade 5. Teachers from each participating class are to select the two best entries from their class for final judging, and based on potential health restrictions, only these two should be submitted. Teachers will keep the rest for display at school, as we will only be displaying the three winning posters for each grade at St. Mary's Church over the Christmas season. Prizes of first, second, and third will be awarded in each of the categories. The prizes will be dropped off at the Schools for presentation the week of December 18 – 22.

Ornament Raffle

The Ornament Raffle began on Monday, December 4th! Proceeds of this fundraiser will be used towards our Christmas Hamper Program which supplies food, gifts/gift certificates for children in the family to families in our school who are in need during the Christmas season.

Draws are made daily throughout the month of December. Students may purchase tickets from their teacher. Tickets are 1 for \$.25 or 6 for \$1.00. All tickets are placed in the draw bin at the office. Each day, 10 student names are drawn and these students are called to the office to select an ornament to take home from our office Christmas tree. To date, we have raised **\$637**!!!
