#### **Inclement Weather**

Please know our school will be open, even with the cold temperatures, but students will remain inside for the recess breaks. We still ask that you send warm outside clothing for your child as skin can freeze with exposure of only 1-2 minutes. We will do our very best to ensure that your child is fully dressed before exiting the school at the end of the day as well. Upon arrival at school in the morning, when the weather is below -25, the doors are unlocked at all entrances and students need to come inside.

#### **School Buses in Inclement Weather:**

The Transportation Manager shall direct a Divisional-wide suspension of rural school bus service in every instance where the temperature is equal to, or colder than, minus forty (40) degrees Celsius, or where the temperature is minus thirty (30) degrees Celsius and a wind chill factor results in a temperature of minus forty (40) degrees Celsius or colder. The temperature will be as reported by The Weather Network at 0615 hours.

Our number one goal, as always, is to ensure that our students are safe. If a bus is cancelled for the morning route then that same bus will not operate in the afternoon. Students on cancelled bus routes will need to be picked up from school at the end of the day.
